## ■ To Launch

- i. From your PC desktop, double-click the "my.invisible" icon.
- ii. Enter your passphrase. Click "OK".
- iii. A window with the icons "Hide File", "Hide Folder" and "Unhide File" will be displayed.

## ■ To Hide File

There are 3 methods of operation:

### After launching my.invisible:

- a. Click the "Hide File" or "Hide Folder" icon. Select the file or folder you want to hide. The file/folder is now invisible.
- b. From your PC desktop, select the file/folder you want to hide. Drag-and-drop it into the my.invisible window. The file/folder is now invisible.

**NOTE:** This option does not work with Microsoft Vista.

### c Without launching my.invisible:

- i. Right-click on the file/folder you want to hide.
- ii. A drop down menu appears, click "Hide File/Folder".
- iii. At the passphrase window, enter your passphrase then click "OK". The file/folder is now invisible.

**NOTE:** The file or folder would also be automatically encrypted for added protection.

## ■ To Unhide File

- i. Right click on any file/folder and click "my.invisible Control Panel" option on the menu. At the passphrase window, enter your passphrase then click "OK".
- ii. Select a hidden file/folder from the list and click "Unhide Item". The file/folder is now visible and appears at its original location.

## ■ To Change Passphrase

- i. Right click on any file/folder and click "my.invisible Control Panel" option on the menu.
- ii. At the passphrase window, click "Passphrase Manager". Enter your current passphrase followed by "New Passphrase".
- iii. Click "Apply".

## ■ Default and Stealth Modes

**DEFAULT MODE:** the my.invisible icon is visible on your desktop.

You can directly click the "Launch SmarThumb my.invisible" icon to launch my.invisible software from the "Desktop"

OR right click any file/folder to launch my.invisible.

**STEALTH MODE:** the my.invisible icon is not visible on your desktop until you hit a hot-key (which you set yourself) to unhide the application.

After you hit the hot-key, the option to "Hide File/Folder" and "my.invisible Control Panel" will appear when you right-click on any file/folder. Please note that the "Launch SmarThumb my.invisible" icon will not appear on the desktop screen as in the Default Mode.

**NOTE:** The "Hide File/Folder" and "my.invisible Control Panel" option will disappear after 5 seconds.

### How to set Stealth Mode:

- i. Right click on any file/folder and click "my.invisible Control Panel" option on the menu.
- ii. At the passphrase window, enter your passphrase and click "OK".
- iii. Click on "Settings" menu, followed by "Change Settings" option.
- iv. Select "Stealth" mode at the mode column, and define your hotkey.
- v. Click "Apply".
- vi. Changes will take effect once you restart your desktop pc/ notebook.

## ■ Warning

my.invisible's function is to only hide a file—it is still physically located at the same place (in a folder or on the desktop).

When you use my.invisible to hide a file that is within a folder, the file is still physically inside the folder. Please note that should you delete the folder, the hidden file will also be AUTOMATICALLY DELETED.

**HINT:** It is best to put all the files that you wish to hide inside one folder, and hide just that particular folder.

**\*NOTE:** Upon installation of my.invisible, you will be asked to enter an "Uninstallation Passphrase". This is to prevent the uninstallation of the software by anyone other than yourself. Remember to keep your "Uninstallation Passphrase" in a safe place (e.g. in SmarThumb my.wallet) to ensure that only you can uninstall the my.invisible software.
